Reading

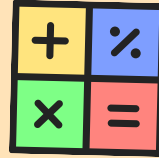
We have started reading our whole class novel 'Space Band'. Using this text we will explore the comprehension strategies of word choice and finding information in a text.

Writing

This term, we will develop our descriptive writing, focusing on the seven descriptors. We will create detailed passages about characters and settings. We will explore personification and similes to make our writing more engaging and imaginative.

Spelling

We will be starting our new spelling approach 'Wraparound Spelling' at the end of September. More information to follow.



Numeracy

This year Mr Brown and Mr Cunningham will teach their own topics each term, please see below what is going to be covered this term.

Mr Cunningham

Mr Cunningham will cover addition, place value, grid referencing and angles.

Mr Brown

Mr Brown will cover the other three operations (subtraction, division and multiplication) and shape.

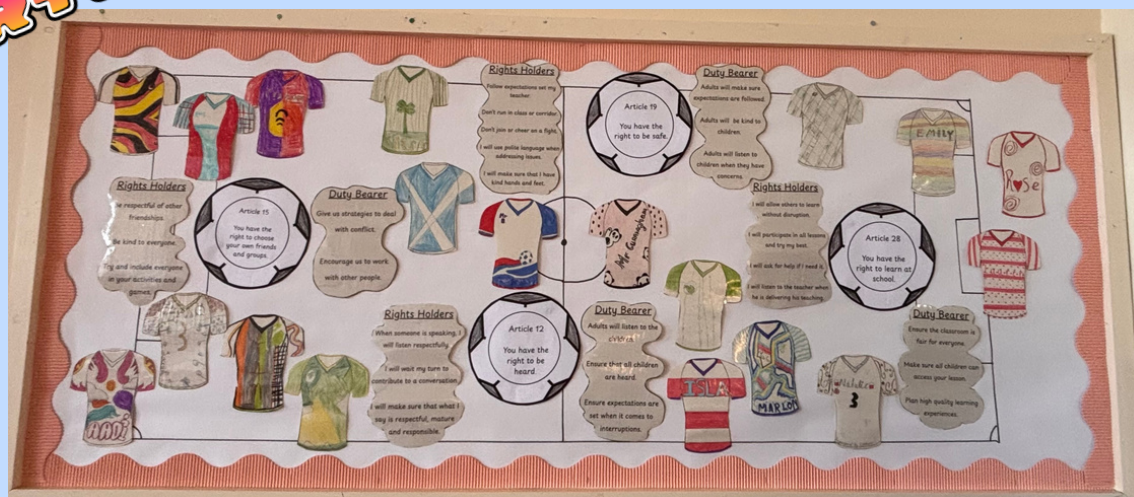
Children will also practise time table knowledge weekly and mental math daily.

- We will also begin exploring sustainability which will be woven throughout the year.
